Automating with Photo Album (PC: Office 2010)

1. Create a folder on your hard drive with JPEG files of each image that you would like to include in your presentation.
2. By default, Photo Album will order your slides by image file name. If you already have a specific order for your presentation in mind, you can rename your image files sequentially. This is especially useful if you plan on having two images per slide. Photo Album will automatically group the images in twos by file name order. You can always move, delete, or add slides or images later.
3. Open PowerPoint and in the Insert menu, select "Photo Album."
4. Click "Insert picture from: File/Disk," select your folder from the file browser, press "control + a" to select all of the images in your folder, and click "Insert." By default, Photo Album will fit each image to display as large as possible within each slide. You can also select options for two-four images per slide with or without titles.
5. Select "Create." PowerPoint will now automatically create the presentation.
